About the Presenters

Glen Boudier, MD – Dr. Boudier received his medical education at West Virginia University. His training includes a pulmonary fellowship at the University of Vermont in Burlington and a critical care fellowship at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN. He has also completed additional training in interventional pulmonology including endobronchial ultrasound (EBUS), electromagnetic navigational bronchoscopy (ENB) and lasers. Dr. Boudier has established three interventional bronchoscopy programs over the last 20 years in support of multidisciplinary lung cancer programs. Most recently he implemented use of the Ion robotic navigational bronchoscopy system at Valley Health as the fourth non-academic site in the country. As part of that effort, he is a national instructor in robotic bronchoscopy. He is board certified in pulmonary and critical care medicine.

William Houck III, MD – Dr. Houck, III, is a partner at Shenandoah Oncology specializing in medical oncology and hematology. He is currently the site research leader, as well as the principal investigator on a number of clinical trials. In addition, he is an adjunct professor at Johns Hopkins University and sees patients at their Breast Cancer Center second opinion clinic. He received his medical degree from the Medical College of Virginia and completed his fellowship in hematology/oncology at Indiana University School of Medicine. He is board certified in medical oncology, hematology, and internal medicine.

Anita Minghini, MD, FACS – Dr. Minghini is a board certified surgeon at the Valley Health Breast Center and serves as the Medical Director of Valley Health's breast care services. She received her medical degree and completed her residency at Eastern Virginia Medical School. She chairs Winchester Medical Center's Breast Care Committee and coordinates the weekly multidisciplinary Breast Tumor Board. She is a regular presenter for Valley Health's Breast Health Symposium held every fall.

Shalini Reddy, MD – Cardiothoracic surgeon Dr. Reddy, of Valley Health Cardiothoracic Surgeons, completed her residency in general surgery at Beth Israel Medical Center in New York. She is fellowship trained in cardiothoracic surgery from SUNY Upstate Medical Center and fellowship trained in minimally invasive thoracic surgery from Roswell Park Cancer Center in New York. She is board certified in general and thoracic surgery.

Patrick Wagner, MD, FACS - Surgical oncologist Dr. Wagner, of Valley Health Surgical Oncology, is board certified in surgery and anatomic pathology. He completed training in cancer surgery and pathology at Weill-Cornell Medical Center, Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center and the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center. Dr. Wagner received his medical degree from Harvard Medical School and during his studies completed a research fellowship through the Howard Hughes Medical Institute. Dr. Wagner has extensive experience in minimally invasive and robotic cancer surgery.
