

TRACKS: Areas of Concentration in FPR

Because of student and resident interest in having areas of added expertise and experience, tracks may be formally developed for residents, with notation of the deeper experience noted on Residency Completion Summary. This uses the resident's Elective time (3 Blocks of 5 weeks) and CME time and scholarly activity. Tracks are optional.

OB:

10 weeks additional OB, to include Advanced OB, vacuum/forceps, OB Ultrasound, and C-Section training if interested.

5 weeks additional NICU, with recertification in NRP

CME: Family Centered Maternity Care

Presentation to Faculty and Residents on OB Topic of choice

EMERGENCY MEDICINE:

10 weeks additional ER rotations, (already all certified in PALS, ATLS)

5 weeks additional Anesthesia for procedures/intubations, etc.

CME: Intensive Emergency Medicine, PALS recertification

Presentation to Faculty and Residents on ER Topic of choice

PEDIATRICS:

5 weeks additional Inpatient Peds (WMC) in winter

5 weeks additional Outpatient Peds

5 weeks Behavioral Peds (coordinate w/Dr Wheat and Winchester Peds Psych)

CME: PALS recertification, NRP recertification

Presentation to Faculty and Residents on Peds Topic of choice

OUTPATIENT PROCEDURES:

5 weeks additional GI: Colonoscopy/EGD

5 weeks additional Cardiology for Treadmills, Cardiolyte Stress, etc.

5 weeks additional ER for multiple outpatient procedures

CME: National Procedure Institute CME

Presentation to Faculty and Residents on Procedure Topic of choice

INTERNATIONAL HEALTH:

5 weeks Infectious Dis prep, then Overseas Medical trip (Ex: Honduras, Ghana, or TenWyk Hosp, Kenya)

5 weeks additional OB to include basics of C-section

5 weeks additional Rural Surgery

CME: Global Medicine

Presentation to Faculty and Residents on Overseas trip findings and plans for use

HOSPITALIST:

5 weeks additional Internal Medicine – WMC Hospitalists

5 weeks additional FP Inpatient Svc WMH

5 weeks additional ICU/Anesthesia procedures

CME: Critical Care Update. Presentation to Faculty and Residents on Inpatient Topic of choice

SCHOLARSHIP/RESEARCH:

5 week Scholarship Elective R-2 and

10 weeks Scholarship Elective R-3 under supervision of Dr Kerns, (details in Elective Handbook)

Accompany Dr Kerns to ACORN research meetings

CME: research conf of choice: ex: NAPCRG, AHRQ, etc.

Presentation to Faculty and Residents on Research done.
